



SUBSIDIZED EMPLOYMENT TRAINING PROGRAM (SET)

Looking for work? Shoreline SET can help! Shoreline will place you in a job and pay 100% of your wages. Through this program, employers can hire new workers while low-income families have the chance to get back to work, make more money, and build their job experience. It's a win-win!

ELIGIBILITY

Santa Cruz parents who have income less than 200% of the Federal poverty level can participate in the SET program. If you are a CalWorks participant, you are eligible for the program. Compare your monthly income with the table below to see if you can participate. If you earn less than what the table says for your family size, you can get a SET job.

You will be required to provide income and family size documentation. In addition to the income requirements, you must be a resident of Santa Cruz county, have a government-issued ID card, and be a parent of a minor child (even if you do not live with that child).

WAGES AND SCHEDULE

All SET jobs pay at least the California minimum wage (\$8.00 per hour) up to the Santa Cruz living wage (\$12.71 per hour). Most jobs will be full-time, though there are opportunities for those interested in part-time work.
